TERMS AND CONDITIONS

If Council agrees to enter into an agreement for construction and maintenance of your fence, the following terms and conditions apply.

- The fence is to be to the set standard as per drawings and details below.
- Any variation to this standard may only be made at the time of application, and on the application form. Council is under no obligation to agree to the variation.
- Any variations and/or concrete plinths are at the cost of the applicant.
- No variations will be permitted that affect the appearance, stability, safety and child resistance of the fence from council's property.
- Council is to be notified prior to construction commencing, and on completion of works.
- Works are to be commenced within one month and completed within three months of the date of agreement.
- Any non-compliance will need to be corrected within fourteen days or will be corrected by Council at cost to applicant.
- The fence is to be neatly fitted to the existing fences at either end to ensure there are no gaps, footholds or sharp objects that can either assist a child in climbing or present a potential safety hazard.
- Repairs of damage to fence are to be rectified by those responsible for the damage.
- Future maintenance of the fence will only be shared between council and owner provided notice of same is given to council and inspections have been carried out.
